Alumni Scholars Program Information for the GUIDANCE COUNSELOR

The Ohio State University Alumni Club of Great Washington, D.C. will sponsor scholarships for high school seniors living in the club area, who plan to attend The Ohio State University. The club's Alumni Scholars Program is based on merit and is a recruitment scholarship. This scholarship program is intended to provide recognition and financial assistance to incoming freshmen or undergraduate students.

Who is eligible?

- Apply to the University by November 1
- Preferably admitted to the university as an incoming freshmen
- Preferably ranked in the top 10% of their high school classes
- Have a record of performance in activities both in school and in the community
- Impress the Scholarship Committee with a sound interest and positive attitude toward college work
- Be residents of and/or attend high school in the area in which the participating alumni club's membership is based

To be considered for a scholarship the student must complete the application, which can be requested from the club's Scholarship Leader.

Completed applications are to be returned to the club scholarship leader by February 15, 2019.
